At the February 20, 2025 Boundary County Library Board of Trustees meeting, Zone 2 Trustee Wendy McClintock tendered her formal resignation from the board.

“It has been a privilege to serve the library and the community in this capacity, and I am grateful for the opportunity to contribute to its mission,” she said.

“I want to extend my thanks to the entire board for your collaboration and dedication to the library’s goals. I am proud of the work we have accomplished together and have full confidence that the library will continue to thrive in the future.”

Wendy McClintock was the current board’s longest serving member, representing her zone for sixteen years. The board thanked her for her service. Her wisdom and experience will be sorely missed.

The Board of Trustees declared a vacancy of the Zone 2 position at the February 20 meeting and, by law, must fill the position within 60 days. Eligible applicants are encouraged to submit a letter of interest to the contact below before the March 20th board meeting.

The Zone 2 position will be open for regular elections in May, so individuals interested in continuing to serve in the position must also submit the proper paperwork to the Boundary County Clerk before the closing date in March. Zone 2 is the Moyie area. Library district zones mirror the Boundary County School District zones.
